The superb **dark skies** of the Yorkshire Dales National Park are one of the things that make it such a special place. Free from light pollution, it is a **stargazer's paradise.**

Where should I go?

You can get fantastic views of the night sky, stars and planets just about anywhere in the National Park. The more remote you are from ambient light sources, including street lamps, the better.

What can I see?

On a clear night you could see as many as **2,000** stars. In most places in the National Park it is possible to see the **Milky Way,** as well as planets, the northern lights, shooting stars – and not forgetting the Moon.

There are four Dark Sky **Discovery Sites** around the National Park
which are a great place to start your
stargazing adventure. These
locations are open to the public,
provide parking and other
facilities and are accessible to
people of all abilities.
